We enjoyed a walk around the school and spotted some daffodils, some snow drops and a blossom tree. For creative time, we made our own blossom trees with the use of pink paint and our finger tips. We discussed baby animals and the children explored a farm tuff tray together. We bought some daffodils and added them to water. The children have enjoyed watching the buds open into flower. We then added them to the tuff tray for the children to see and draw. Next week is Easter Week. The children will enjoy a range of crafts relating to this theme.



**RECEPTION** - Reception have enjoyed spending lots of time in the outdoor area this week in the lovely spring weather. We have been checking our plants and making sure they are well watered. **FORM 2** - This week in Form 2, we have been learning to measure in millilitres and litres. We have learned that vibrations pass from a sound source to particles in the air and these vibrations reach our ears where they are changed into electrical signals which are sent to the brain. Then, the brain tells us what we are hearing. This week we made string telephones and experimented to see how these worked. Despite the knots, we were impressed with how well these worked. *Mrs Baron* 



**FORM 6** - Form 6 are learning all about light this half term. We have studied how light travels and how shadows are created. We had fun this week doing refraction experiments. We saw how a pencil appears broken when half submerged in a cup of water. We also carried out the reappearing coin trick by slowly pouring water into a cup with a coin stuck to the bottom. We also learned about the visible light spectrum and how white light is made up of seven colours. We learned how refraction through a prism causes the light to refract and split into its different colours. We then made a Newton disk and mastered spinning it to see how the colours blend back together to create a whiteish shade if you can spin the disk fast enough. Just like a yoyo perseverance was needed to master the technique but most of the class were successful!
