FORM 5 - Over half term Mrs Clark and Mrs Mays weeded and prepared the flower bed next to Form 6 in preparation for Form 5 to plant some bee friendly plants. The flower bed already has a super bug hotel and we wanted to encourage a wider range of pollinating insects to the area.

Form 5 researched the importance of bees to the planet and mankind, discovering that over 70% of the food we eat relies on the pollination provided by bees. The children were shocked to learn that there are over 800 species of bees worldwide with more than 270 of these being found in the UK!

On Tuesday the children worked in pairs to plant a variety of plants in the flower bed, with the assistance of Mrs Mays. The plants included 2 varieties of Salvia, Phlox, Astrantia and Echinacea. The children will be taking turns to water the plants to ensure they are well established by the summer holidays.

In the Autumn term the children will also be planting a variety of bulbs which will provide some beautiful early Spring
