

He was able to tell the story of how 800 fishing and pleasure boats crossed the Channel ,under constant fire by the Germans, then managed to



rescue over three thousand British troops. He showed the children the medals he won after the war. Mr Edward Harvey was a war Hero receiving the Croix de Roi Albert medal from Belgium. Form 5 were mesmerised by his story and asked many questions at the end. A very big Thank you to Mr Harvey for coming in to share the memories of his father with us.
