Dear Parents



children are enjoying the WWII topic and if they have any memorabilia they would like to share they are welcome to bring it in. In Science we have been learning about the Geocentric versus Heliocentric theories that have lead to our current model of the solar system. The class acted out a play where they were various scientists from the Early Humans right through to Isaac Newton to help them learn some of the key events in the formulations of the current model. In English we have been working a lot on improving our figurative language and descriptive writing. The children have written some brilliant animal descriptions.

NURSERY - This week Nursery have enjoyed the Topic: Autumn and Harvest. Thank you so much for our Harvest Festival donations, our box is almost full! The children have been learning their new Autumn Song and have loved singing it together. The children also enjoyed some music and movement together in the hall. RECEPTION & FORM I - On Tuesday, Reception and Form I walked to Maldon Library and took part in a Traditional Tales Workshop. The workshop included discussions about lots of different stories, exploring the library and lots of reading! All the children thoroughly enjoyed exploring the different sections within the library and were excited to choose lots of different books to read by themselves and with their class friends.

FORM 6 - Form 6 have spent the week looking at micro organisms. Our latest experiment investigated the effect temperature has on the reaction between yeast and sugar and it highlighted some interesting facts about

yeast. We were shocked to learn that a single gram of yeast contains 25 billion cells. We are also looking forward to growing some bacteria early next week.

PRE-RECEPTION - Pre-Reception have started our Autumn/Harvest topic. We took a trip into town to buy some harvest vegetables to do some vegetable printing. The children were very good at spotting the vegetables and remembering what we needed as we forgot to take a shopping list! Pre-Reception then enjoyed printing with
